OLIVER "Jerry" HARMON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men have established this Award to assist young men and women in pursuit of academic excellence in institutions of higher learning and to encourage their participation in community-based activities with the desired goal of improving the conditions of that community. The award is to be used for tuition and/or other college expenses.

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

- 1. An announcement of the procedures and the application for applying for a CCBCM Scholarship Award will be provided by the CCBCM Scholarship Committee to all high schools located in Prince George's County, Maryland and posted to the CCBCM website (www.ccbcm.org) sometime between January 2 March 15.
- 2. The CCBCM Scholarship Award will be made in two payments one for the fall semester during the month of August and the second payment in January contingent upon the recipient emailing their fall semester grades and their spring schedule to ccbcm@verizon.net.
- 3. Attendance of the recipient or their representative is mandatory at our annual scholarship event in order to receive the scholarship award.
- 4. Incomplete scholarship application submissions will not be considered. Applicants must submit all required documents as outlined under the CRITERIA SECTION of the scholarship application. Letters of Recommendations must be current to coincide with the scholarship application term.
- 5. The Scholarship Award recipient(s) will be determined by the CCBCM Scholarship Committee and notified by email.

CRITERIA

- 1. The Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from a high school in Prince George's County, Maryland or a returning college student who must be a resident of Prince George's County, Maryland.
- 2. Applicant must submit an Official School Transcript (College & High School Students) and an Official copy of SAT or ACT scores (High School Students Only).
- 3. Applicant must provide proof of acceptance for admission and confirmation from the University or College of their choice or show proof of being currently enrolled in a University or College.
- 4. Applicant must submit two (2) current letters of recommendation from a school official, instructor, or community leader.
- 5. Applicant must submit a completed application package to the CCBCM Scholarship Committee by the deadline indicated underneath your signature on the last page of the application.
- 6. Applicant must submit a 350-word, double-spaced essay along with the Scholarship Application and required documents. The essay should outline the reasons for applying for the CCBCM Scholarship Award and address the following:
 - a. The responsibilities of a successful scholarship recipient, and
 - b. The importance of civic and social engagement within the community.
- 7. The Award may be used for undergraduate or vocational private career studies.
