The Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men (CCBCM) is proud to announce we are celebrating our 38th year anniversary and would like to thank you for any past contributions. The CCBCM is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and our mission is to operate on a non-profit basis with an all-volunteer membership that provides resources in support of educational opportunities, social assistance and community involvement to help enhance the quality of life for the people in our communities. Our 2025 fund raising scholarship and awards breakfast program will be held on Saturday June 21, 2025, (9:00 - 11:30am) at Martin's Crosswinds, 7400 Greenway Center Drive, Greenbelt, Maryland 20770. Some of our other programs include providing food to families and food pantries in need of assistance on a monthly basis through the Self Help and Resource Exchange (SHARE) center (www.sharedc.org); Providing monetary support and toys to families in need of assistance for Thanksgiving and Christmas and doing volunteer work in the community, such as, supporting Prince George's county annual Christmas in April program.

Since 1993 we have awarded \$603,000 dollars in scholarships to (667) students, since 2002 provided \$181,985 in food, toys and donations to persons in need of assistance and since March 2020 provided \$37,360 to persons impacted by COVID-19. The only way our organization is able to provide these scholarships, donations, toys and food baskets are with the support of the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) of the National Capital Area Agency #96257 (www.cfcna.org), grants and generous donations from corporations, non-profits and individual sponsors, such as, yourself.

Last year we awarded \$41,000 in scholarships and our goal for 2025 is \$50,000.
